Michael Wilkinson

Mike grew up in the Wisconsin Heights school district and started high school in 1996, graduating in 2000. During Mike's senior year of high school basketball, he was awarded the "Mr. Basketball" award, which is given each year to Wisconsin's player of the year in boys basketball.

After graduating from Wisconsin Heights High School, Mike went on to play for the Wisconsin Badgers. He red-shirted his freshman year, and then played four years thereafter, graduating from UW-Madison in 2005. While playing for the Badgers he averaged 14.3 points per game and during his senior year at the UW, Mike was selected to the All-Big Ten Conference First Team.

After graduating from UW-Madison in 2005, Mike went on to play overseas for a total of 9 years, playing in several different countries. From 2005-2007, he played for Aris B.C. , which is in Greece. From 2007-2009, he played for Khimki, which is in Russia. From 2009-2010, Mike played for Galatasary in Turkey. He then went back to Russia, and played for Lokomotiv from 2010-11, and then Unics Kazan from 2011-2013. He then finished his career in Bulgaria, playing for Levski from 2013-2014.

After his amazing high school, college, and professional careers, Mike has returned back to the area and is running the family farm that he grew up on, raising grass-fed highland beef and cash crops. Mike also owns an asphalt and pavement maintenance tool distribution company.

Mike is really looking forward to coming to this camp to interact and play with the kids, and we are definitely excited to have him come in and help us out as well! During one of the days of camp, Mike will join in with the kids, doing some of the drills with your son, and also play some games with them.
